#### (CTT Bank)

It was created and is already operational in about 50 post offices the CTT bank.

Always denied the public CTT's, was offered to privatized CTT's.

Besides (around) 100 workers admitted to the Bank management, not a single worker was admitted to the post offices network.

The whole operation will be carried out by personnel already there, that assured the bank services in addition with the postal services, without any extra pay.

The implementation of the postal services is the least important in those post offices. The first cases of physical and mental exhaustion are already being felt among those workers. One day we will give account of the outcome of this adventure ...



## **NEAR FUTURE**

The renegotiation of the Collective Agreement CTT is not far away.

Last week CTT have announced the creation of a pension fund to which they wish to transfer health "post-employment" responsibilities. With that they announce that they want to jeopardize the private health and social assistance system (IOS\_CTT), which depends from the Collective Agreement and that only can be changed with the agreement of all parties.

I may be wrong but, there is always a but, the near future in the CTT Portuguese Posts should be very troubled ...
